WHO CAN APPLY:

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE:

Applications will be accepted until midnight on **Friday, March 15, 2024**. No late applications will be considered.

WHAT ARE THE SELECTION CRITERIA:

Scholarship recipients will be chosen at the Association's discretion, based on the **activities** within their resume, and the short **essay**. Incomplete applications or applications which are not in compliance with the instructions provided may be discarded at the Association's discretion.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS:

Scholarship recipients will be notified on or by May 3, 2024.

Upon selection of scholarship award winners, all applications and enclosures will be destroyed.
