**SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS**

To help young women continue their education and to encourage sororities to maintain high scholastic standards, the Los Angeles Alumnae Panhellenic Association will award a total of three \$1000 scholarships, available to women attending LMU, UCLA, and/or USC.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

These awards will be given to the women who most exemplify sorority ideals. To qualify for these awards, applicants must:

- Be designated as a Sophomore, Junior or Senior status at her university for the **2016-2017** academic year;
- Have a grade point average of 3.0 or higher;
- Be a current, active participant in her sorority\* (at application submission and upon receipt of scholarship funds / 2016-2017 academic year) ;

**and**

- Be involved in either university activities or in community/volunteer projects. (e.g. day care centers, tutorial programs, philanthropic fundraising events, etc.).

Please indicate the time spent in each activity (e.g. orchestra, 5-10 hrs/week).

Scholarship winners will be announced by March 1, 2016 and will be presented in the Spring.

- Applications must be signed by the applicant and the applicant's chapter advisor. Applications without the advisor's signature will be disqualified. The applicant may fax or otherwise electronically send the completed application and essay to the advisor and have them sign the document. If applicable, both the original and the separate copy with the advisor signature must be submitted by **January 31, 2016**. They may be sent separately with a note stating that two copies each with one original signature will be sent. **Applications that do not meet this January 31, 2016, deadline will be disqualified.**
