SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

The Los Angeles Alumnae Panhellenic Association (LAAPA) will award a total of three \$1000 scholarships to sorority women attending either CSULA, LMU, UCLA, or USC during the 2017-2018 academic year. The purpose of these awards is to assist collegiate sorority women in successfully continuing their education and to encourage sororities in always maintaining high scholastic standards.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The LAAPA Scholarship awards will be given to three collegiate women who most exemplify sorority and scholastic ideals. To qualify for these awards, applicants must:

- Be designated as a Sophomore, Junior or Senior status at her university for the **2017-2018** academic year;
- Be an active and in good standing member of a recognized National Panhellenic Conference* sorority upon application submission (January 31, 2017) and upon receipt of scholarship funds (March 2017)
- Have a cumulated college grade point average of **3.0 or higher**;
- Be involved in either unpaid university activities and/or community/volunteer/philanthropic activities
