



## LOS ANGELES ALUMNAE PANHELLENIC ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR THE 2021-2022 ACADEMIC YEAR

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

The Los Angeles Alumnae Panhellenic Association (LAAPA) will award a total of three \$1,000 scholarships to sorority women attending either CSULA, LMU, UCLA, or USC during the 2021-2022 academic year. The purpose of these awards is to assist collegiate sorority women in successfully continuing their education and to encourage sororities in always maintaining high scholastic standards.

### QUALIFICATIONS:

The LAAPA Scholarship awards will be given to three collegiate women who most exemplify sorority and scholastic ideals. To qualify for these awards, applicants must:

- Be designated as a Sophomore, Junior or Senior status at her university for the **2021-2022** academic year;
- Be an active and in good standing member of a recognized National Panhellenic Conference\* sorority upon application submission (February 1, 2021) and upon receipt of scholarship funds (Spring 2021).
- Have a cumulative college grade point average of **3.0 or higher**;
- Be involved in either unpaid university activities and/or community/volunteer/philanthropic activities

If applicable, both the original and the copy with the Chapter Advisor's signature must be submitted via email to Samanaz Kapadia, the LAAPA Scholarship Chairperson, by **February 1, 2021**. **Applications that do not meet the February 1, 2021 deadline will be disqualified.**
