SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:

Los Angeles Alumnae Panhellenic Association (LAAPA) will award a total of three \$1,000 scholarships to sorority women attending either CSULA, LMU, UCLA, or USC during the 2023-2024 academic year. The purpose of these awards is to assist collegiate sorority women in successfully continuing their education and to encourage sororities in always maintaining high scholastic standards.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The LAAPA Scholarship awards will be given to three collegiate women who most exemplify sorority and scholastic ideals. To qualify for these awards, applicants must:

- 1. Be designated as a Freshman, Sophomore, Junior or Senior status at her university for the **2023-2024** academic year;
- Be an active and in good standing member of a recognized National Panhellenic Conference* (NPC) sorority upon application submission (February 15, 2023) and upon receipt of scholarship funds (Spring 2023.)
- 3. Have a cumulative college grade point average of 3.0 or higher;
- 4. Be involved in either unpaid university activities and/or community / volunteer / philanthropic activities.

If applicable, both the original and the copy with the Chapter Advisor's signature must be submitted via email to Melinda Kelly, the LAAPA Scholarship Chairperson, by <u>February 15, 2023</u>. Applications that do not meet the February 15, 2023 deadline will be disqualified.
